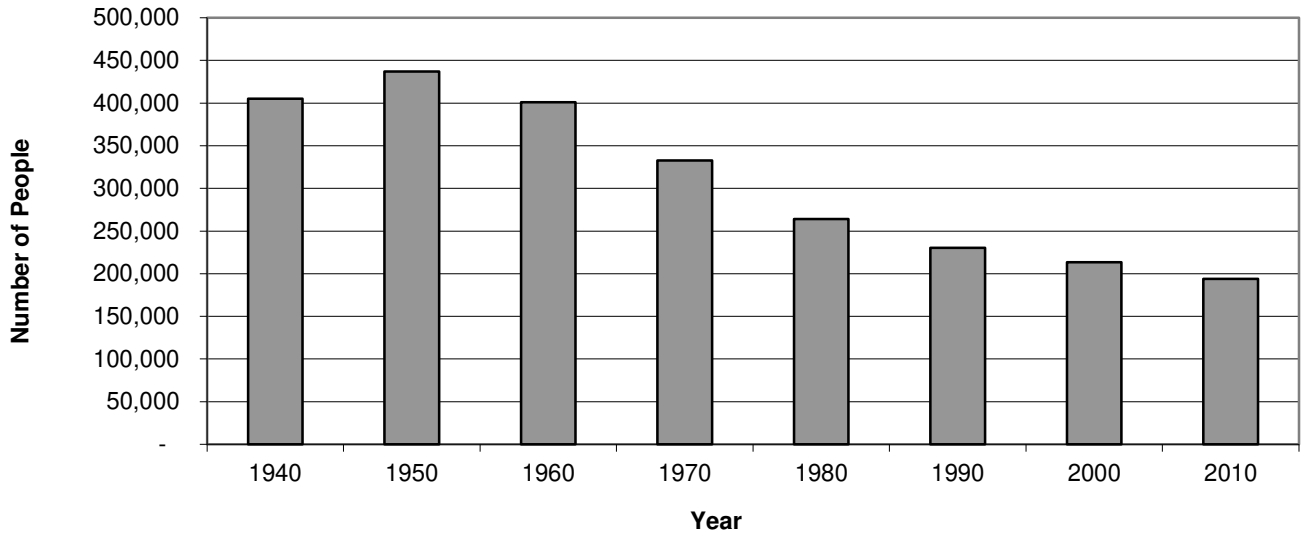

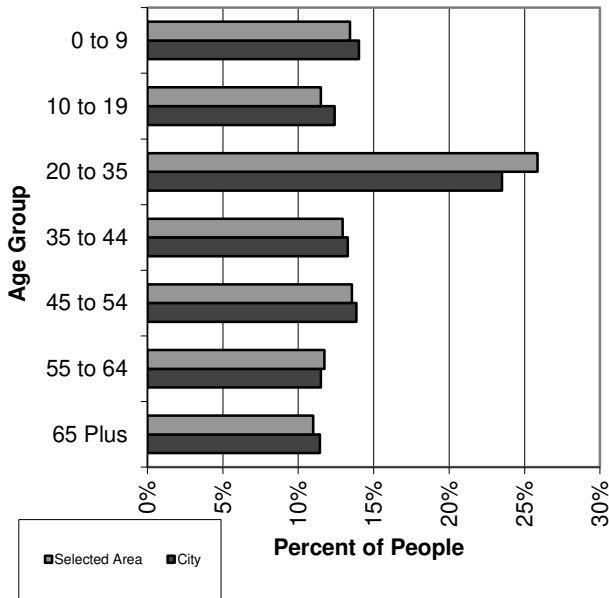

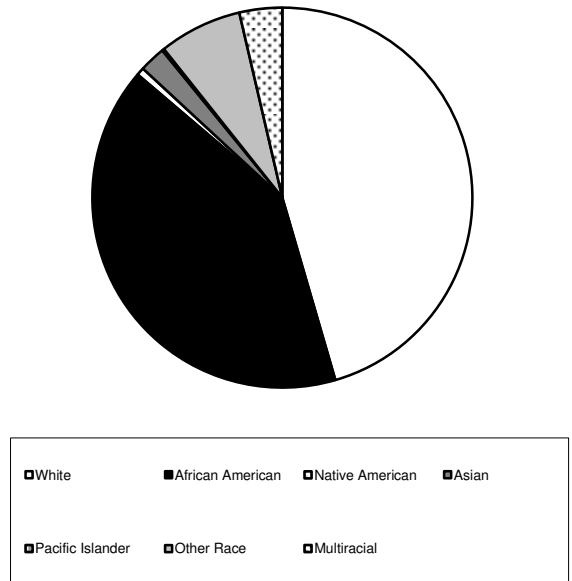
NUMBER OF PEOPLE

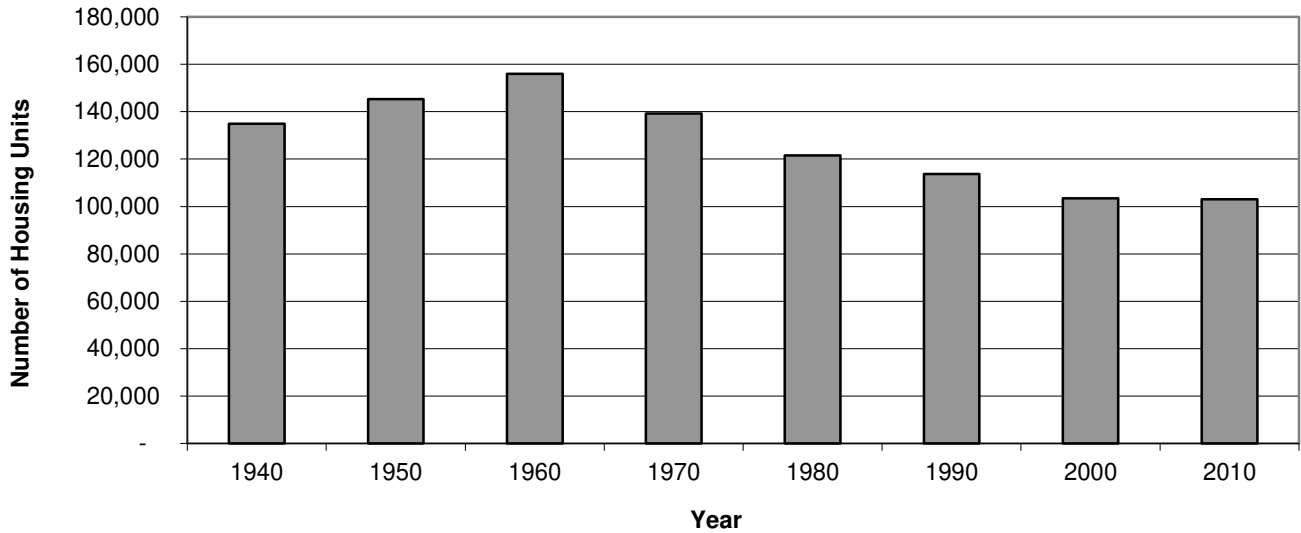

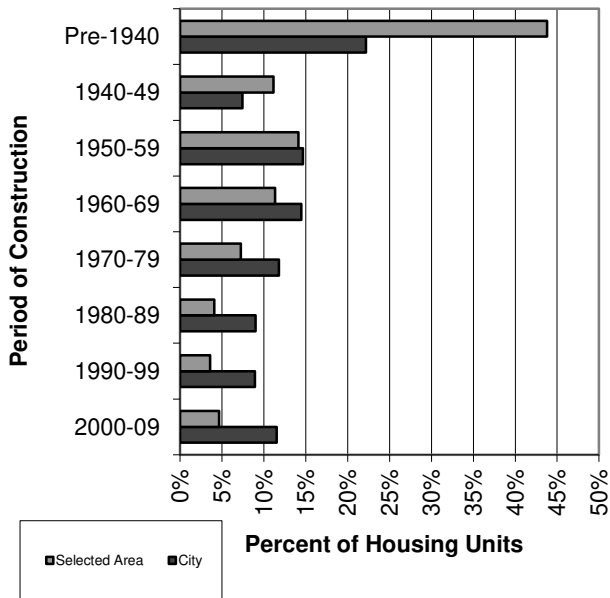
HOUSING UNITS

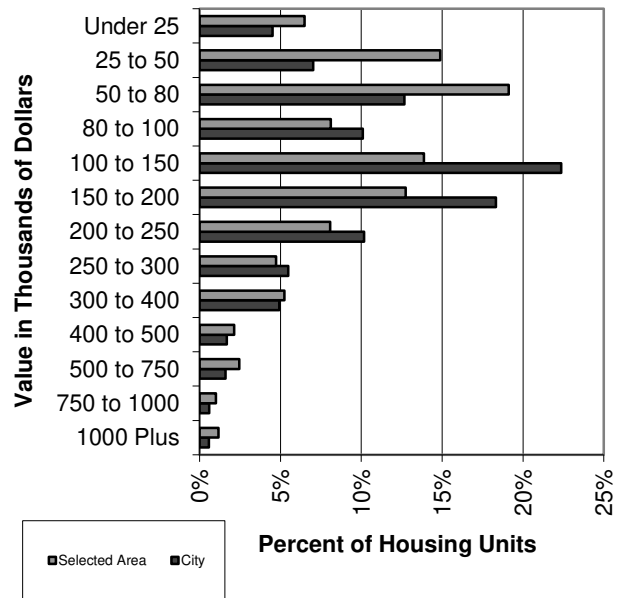
YEAR CREATED

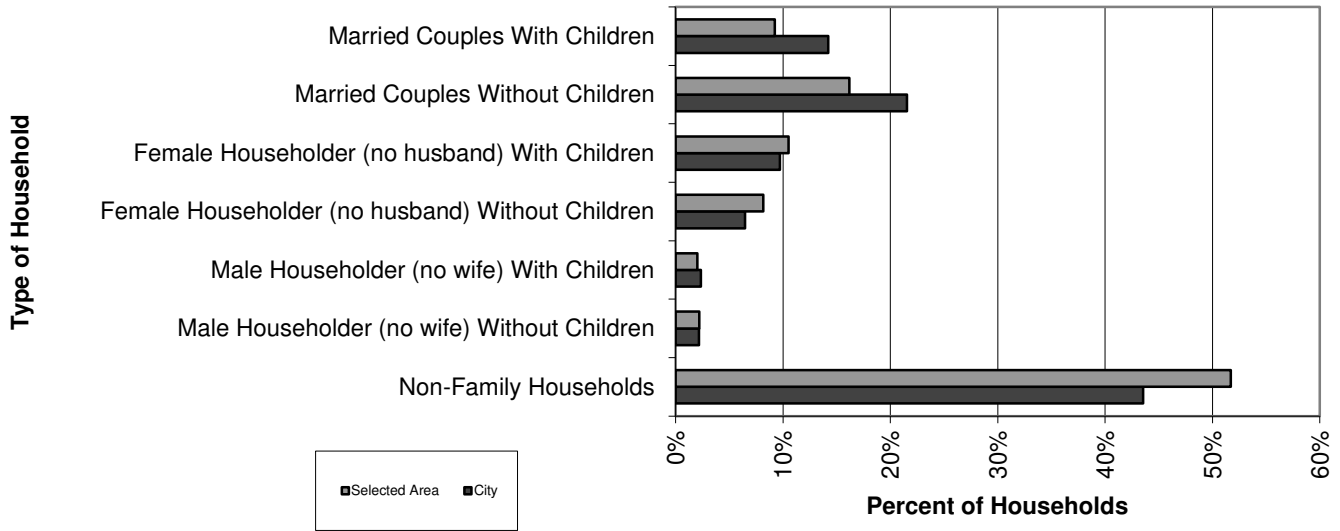

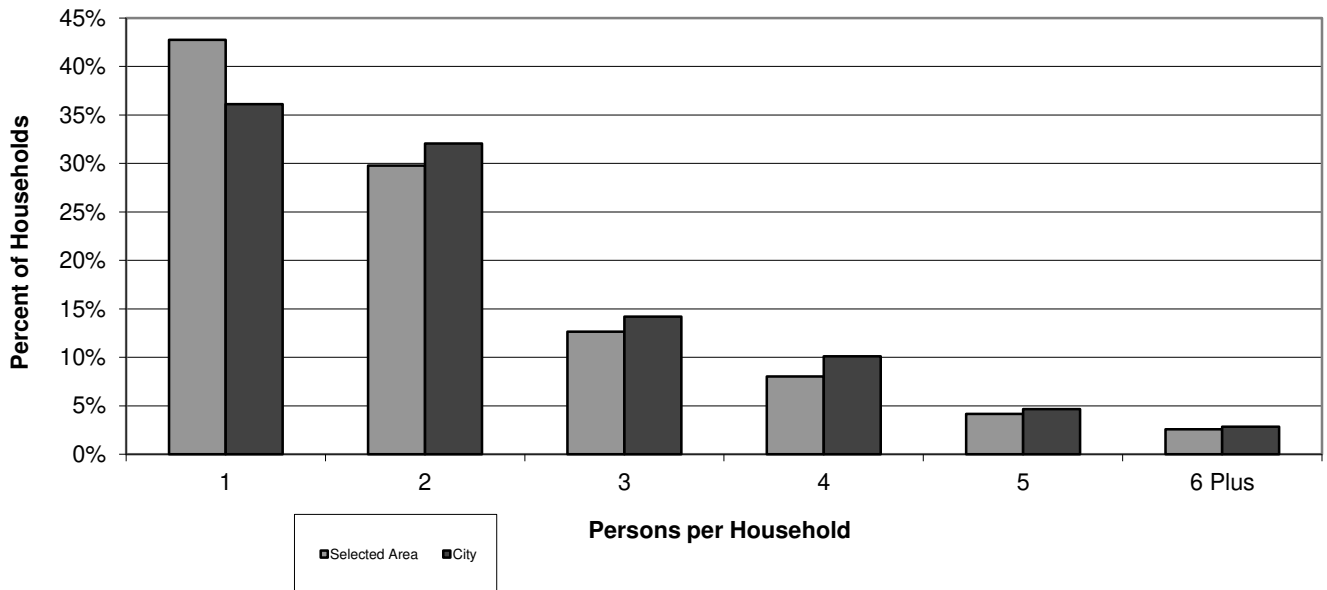
TYPES OF HOUSEHOLDS

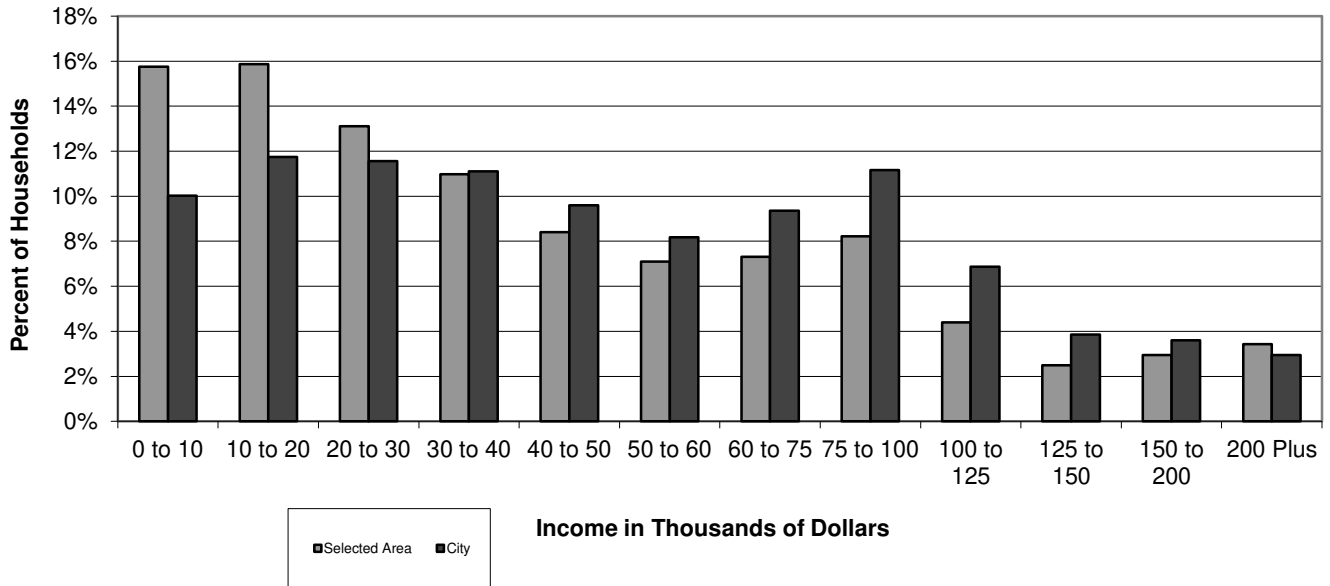

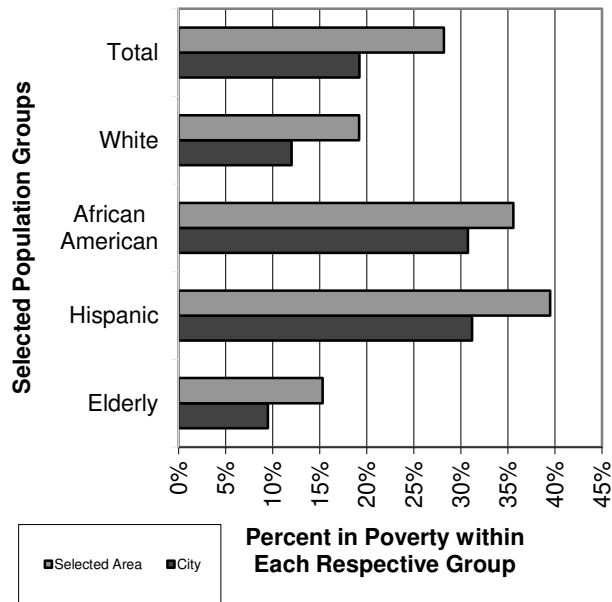
INCOME OF HOUSEHOLDS

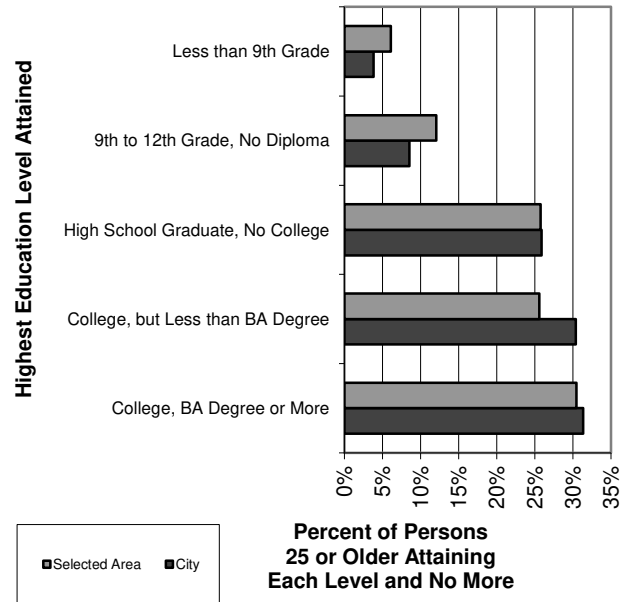
POVERTY STATUS
