Data in shaded cells are based upon data from the 2012-2016 ACS.

Data for census tracts split by the Kansas City, MO City Limits have been proportioned to conform with shares inside and outside the city in the 2008-2012 American Community Survey, the last one to address such splits. Geography is kept constant to reflect 2010 census geography and 2010 city limits in data presented for earlier years.

Franklin County, KS was removed from the metro area in 2013 and is no longer reflected in metro statistics for this report.







Numbers of homes falling in each 2012-2016 category were interpolated according to where the inflated 1980, 1990 and 2000 thresholds fell.






