

- ☐ 26,762 students attend public schools within KCPS boundaries; public school enrollment has grown for 5 consecutive years, driven by charter enrollment growth
- ☐ The majority of students attend schools of choice schools that require an application to attend (KCPS Signature + Charter = 60% of all public enrollment)
- ☐ 24% of all 3rd graders read on grade level; the MO state average is 49%. Third-grade reading proficiency is highly predictive of high school graduation and life outcomes
